

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HETHE PARISH) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Hethe Parish) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
4. The Oxfordshire County Council (Hethe Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2003 is hereby revoked/replaced.

SCHEDULE

20mph speed limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Hethe extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Bainton Road	a point 100 95 metres south of its junction with Hardwick Road.
b)	Hardwick Road	a point 308 315 metres northwest of its junction with Bainton Road.
c)	Main Street	a point 122 125 metres southwest of its junction with the road running northwest from Fringford to the B4031 Cottisford Road.
